


Guide for UniToken WebAuthentication

Init Tool

UniToken Init is a graphical user interface (GUI) tool that helps software developer to set up UniToken parameters for web users.

Getting started

1. Select the right UniToken init application according to your web design language, so far our product can support ASP, ASP.NET and PHP. And then double click the UniToken Init icon.



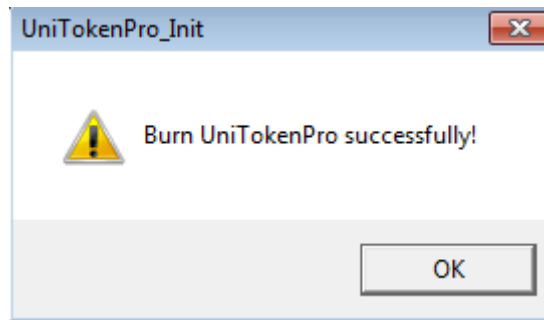

A UniToken Init window will appear as above, enter UserID (less than 16 Char); Check Auto, if you want to let system generate credential automatically, or you have to define by yourself; enter UserPIN used for users to logon their UniToken Pro device or check Default if the UserPIN is factory default (user); and enter Server URL, which specifies where your website is available.

UniToken Init tool can be used to change User PIN as well. To achieve this, just check Change User PIN, and enter NewUserPIN and double enter to confirm.

3. Click Burn to start burn your settings into your UniToken.



Congratulations! You have burn you UniToken successfully if you see the above window appear.

4. An insert SQL command line will be added into the ImportSql.sql file which is in the same folder where UniToken Init is located. Open this file by Notepad, and you can add the new records into the SQL database used to store user information. For more information, please watch the Video Tutorial Guides.
